1 a	Continued professional development to ensure effective T & L.	£1500
b	Year 11 after school and lunchtime intervention classes to tackle performance in targeted areas.	£13,776
c	Lunchtime catch up club enabling pupils throughout the school but those particularly in Y11 to catch up with missed work.	£1000
d	After school home learning club for identified pupils who need support in order to keep up with home learning, support available from either a teacher, TA or sixth formers who can focus on particular subjects.	£280
e	GCSE textbooks purchased for pupils who need extra texts to support their learning.	£1250
f	Easter revision classes.	£2919
g	Year 11 mock results day	£250
2 a	Year 11 mentoring.	£5600
b	Careers support and advice from careers advisor in school.	£2200
c	Subsidised of fully funded music lessons building on the strong links between learning an instruments and academic progress.	£300
d	Extra support on how to revise and how to pass GCSE exams.	£500
e	Purchase of more technological aids for example laptops which could be used to supplement the schools stock or loaned to specific pupils.	£2000
f	Continued development of the school online portal that significantly aids all students with their organisation of home learning but has a disproportional impact on those from a disadvantaged background.	£4500
