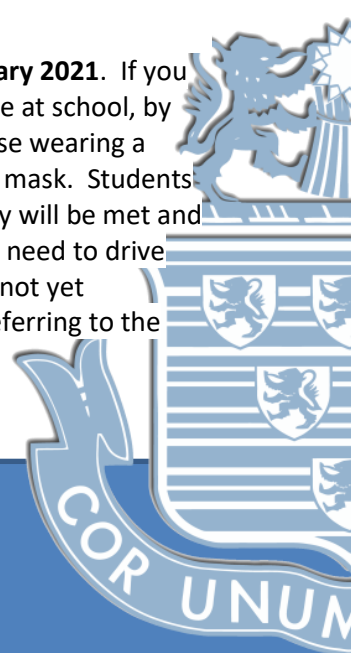
The **Men ACWY Booster vaccinations for Y9-10 are still going ahead on Thursday 25 February 2021**. If you have registered to give your consent, you will be sent a time slot for your son/daughter to be at school, by the school nursing team. Students do not need to come in school uniform, but I would advise wearing a short sleeved top to make access to the arm for vaccination easy and they must also wear a mask. Students will need to report to the new sports hall during their allocated vaccination time, where they will be met and registered. Please could we ask that students come in to school on their own and if parents need to drive them in, that they remain in their car to limit numbers and interactions on site. If you have not yet completed registration for these vaccinations, please could you do so before half term by referring to the attached letters.
