**You have received this email because you have consented for your child to have the Men ACWY & Td/IPV vaccinations in School.**

**Please do not share this letter.**

Further to the recent government announcement of national lockdown on 4<sup>th</sup> January I am writing to confirm that the forthcoming programme for Men ACWY & Td/IPV booked to be delivered in your child's school during this time is still going ahead due to the importance of these vaccinations.

Your child will need to attend:

**If your child is in Year 9 & Year 10 they will need to attend on: Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> February**

Please attend at the allocated time below depending on the first letter of your child's surname;

Surname A-I between 9.45am and 11:15am

Surname J-R between 11:15am and 12.45pm

Surname S-Z between 12.45pm and 2:15pm

This is to manage student numbers in school whilst COVID-19 restrictions remain in force.

Please note your child may need to queue for their vaccination.

Your child will need to wear a face mask whilst on site unless they are exempt.

Please be aware that parents will not be allowed in school premises and parking may not be available on site.

Conscious of the ongoing Covid-19 situation we plan to ensure

- All School Immunisation Service staff are completing lateral flow tests twice weekly.
- Students will be asked to keep to social distancing whilst on site.
- All equipment used is cleaned appropriately according to Infection Prevention & Control Covid guidance.

- On arrival all surfaces within the designated vaccination area will be cleaned.
- Face masks are worn by Immunisation Team staff on entrance to school and throughout the duration of the visit.
- Aprons will be worn by vaccinating staff.
- Hands will be sanitised between every child and fully washed at appropriate opportunities
- The Immunisation process will be performed on a one to one basis to reduce contact for students and staff.
- Windows will be opened where possible.
- As students are purely attending school for their vaccinations and may attend unaccompanied as parents/carers are working we plan to monitor all unaccompanied students on site for 10-15 minutes post their vaccination before letting them leave.
- Accompanied students will be able to leave immediately.
- Included with this email are the patient information leaflets for both vaccines for your information.

If this appointment is not convenient please be aware that a further opportunity will be offered, however this may not be on a school site.
